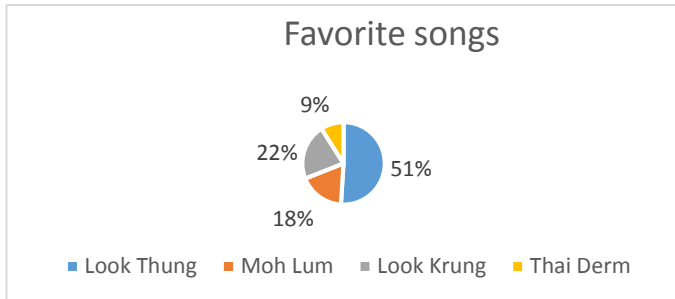

Man has learnt to make use of water in many ways. Irrigation is important in growing crops. Water is obtained from rivers by making canals. **Extra** water is also taken away through these canals. In places where rainfall is uncertain, rivers are blocked up by dams to make reservoirs. These reservoirs store up the much-needed water for use in dry seasons.
